Description

The Kings Revival Children's Home was established in 2005 and aims to take care of abandoned and orphaned by offering support and shelter. Currently 34 children live in the home in two residential buildings, one for boys and one for girls. The land on which the home is situated is the property of the foundation. All of the children go to school and also receive supplemental schooling and computer training. The older children learn a trade in the vocational training centre.

Due to the increased demand for shelter, there is a need for an additional residential building for 20 boys. In consultation with the foundation, the contractor and the Vebeego Foundation, the decision was made to realise this project in 2013 and 2014.

In October 2013 and in February 2014 employees of Vebeego companies worked together with local builders on the construction of this residential building.
